Musicians **aged 18 to 26** who perform violin may submit their application to the Orchestral academy's two year programme. In their study of orchestral parts and preparations for rehearsals and concerts, Academy members will be guided by leading players of the orchestra. The programme focuses not only on orchestral repertoire, but also provides Academy members with the possibility of performing publicly at the Philharmonic's chamber subscription concerts.

Requirements for the audition:

1. First movement of a classic concerto (own choice) – not required for percussion and trumpets
2. J. Haydn – Concerto for trumpet and orchestra E flat Major, 1st and 2nd movement – required only for trumpets
3. A solo composition without accompaniment (own choice, max. 10 minutes) – not required for trumpets
4. Performance of repertory orchestral parts

Repertory orchestral parts will be send together with the invitation letter right after the deadline of the applications by e-mail said by the applicant in the application form.

Applications in writing, with a structured CV (including basic contacts) and letter of motivation must be sent to the following address by 4 December 2022:
